Climbing Mt. Fuji is Very dangerous

outside of the official climbing season.

In general, Mt.Fuji is open to climbers from July 10th to September 10th.

Please refrain from climbing.

The trail between the 5th station and the summit of Mt.Fuji is closed in accordance with Article 46 of the Road Act.

Climbing prohibited

The Fujinomiya route from the 5th to 6th station has a different opening period from the other sections.

Violation of the law may result in imprisonment for up to six months or a fine of up to 300,000yen. No guarantee of safety while the mountain is closed to climbers.

- The climbing environment is different from the officcial climbing season, with severe weather conditions, drops in temperature, and an increased risk of falling rocks, making it very dangerous.
- High winds, snowfall or other factors may make walking impossible, or may cause climbers to slip or fall.
- No evacuation site as first-aid stations, bathrooms and mountain lodges are closed.
- The hiking trail is not maintaind and guide signs and ropes are inadequate.
- Mobile phone reception is poor.
- Rescue operation/mission may not be carried out due to weather conditions and other factors.
