

For Descending!! (Refer to back)

From the Summit to Edoya hut, "The Yoshida Trail" and "The Subashiri Trail" are the same Route.

Turn left at the Shita-edoya hut to go on the Yoshida Trail.

Yoshida Trail

The ascending route is marked in Orange.

From the Summit to Edoya Hut, please use the toilet at Fujisan Hotel.

If you are unable to get to the summit, turn around and **walk back down** the ascending trail.



*Note: The red text is not related to the Yoshida Trail.



Descending route: Approx. 120 min from Original 8th Sta. to the 6th Sta. Safety Guidance Center

There are signposts on the corners of the descending route. The numbers shown on the right of the signposts represent the approximate times for descent.






Follow your guide's instructions



Wear a helmet




Avoid climbing in casual clothing

* Deposit : ¥2,000 ▶ Missing or damaged helmets will forfeit the deposit.

* **Make absolutely sure to return the helmet.**

◎Use of toilets on the descending route

*Toilets on the descending trail are located at the 7th Station (public toilet) and the Mt. Fuji Safety Guidance Center (6th Station). The area around the toilets can be crowded, so please keep your distance from other hikers.

*Toilet upkeep on the Yoshida Trail is done thanks to the goodwill of participants. When using these toilets, please pay  the **toilet tip**.

*Be respectful and sanitary when using the toilets. The Yoshida Trail toilet is open 24 hours.
