

吉田ルート YOSHIDA Trail

吉田ルートは、富士スバルライン五合目から登り始める富士登山で最も人気のある登山道です。山頂までの標高差は約1,450m。登り下りが別道で、ルート上には富士登山道で最も多くの山小屋があります。

A popular route with varied terrain, including forested sections, zigzag trails across volcanic gravel, and steep rocky climbs. Because the route faces northeast, climbers can enjoy beautiful sunrise views from the mountain. On clear days, you can also look out over a sea of clouds and see Lake Yamanaka as well as the mountains of the Yatsugatake Range and the Southern Alps.



YOSHIDA Trail Ascent route



登山道の五合目～六合目は樹林帯の緩やかな登りです。六合目以降は火山砂礫のジグザグ道が続き、七合目付近からは急な岩場が本格化します。八合目中盤からは登りにくい砂礫道が増え、本八合目で須走ルートと合流するためこの辺りは大変混雑します。九合目～山頂にかけては道が狭く、急峻な岩場が続くため落石の注意が必要です。

From the 5th to the 6th Station, the trail is a gentle climb through forest. Beyond the 6th Station, the route continues along zigzag paths on volcanic gravel. Around the 7th Station, steep rocky sections begin to appear. From the middle of the 8th Station area, the trail becomes a difficult gravel path, and it becomes very crowded near the Original 8th Station where the Subashiri Trail merges with the Yoshida Trail. From the 9th Station to the summit, the trail is narrow with steep rocky sections, so caution is required due to the risk of falling rocks.

YOSHIDA Trail Descent route



下山は下山専用ルートを使います。山小屋やトイレが少ないので注意が必要です。登り同様に山頂から八合目までは岩場や砂礫の急な下りで、滑りやすい区間が続きます。また、八合目江戸屋(下江戸屋)付近で須走ルートとの分岐があるので間違えないようにしましょう(黄色標識確認必須)。八合目以降はブルドーザー跡の下山専用道を利用します。ジグザグ砂礫道の傾斜は緩やかですが砂埃が舞うのでマスクやサングラスがあると良いでしょう。

The descent uses a separate trail designated only for descending. There are few mountain huts or toilets along this route, so please plan accordingly. Similar to the ascent, the section from the summit down to the 8th Station consists of steep rocky and gravel slopes that can be slippery. Near Hachigome Edoya (Shimo-Edoya), there is a junction with the Subashiri Trail, so be careful not to take the wrong path and follow the yellow trail markers. Below the 8th Station, the descent continues along a dedicated route that follows former bulldozer tracks. The zigzag gravel trail here has a gentler slope, but dust can easily be kicked up, so wearing a mask or sunglasses is recommended.
